Please be advised that there will be a Town Meeting, held on Thursday, January 24, 2019, at 7:00 P.M. at the Stafford Senior Center, to propose a bond of \$6 million.

The proposed bond will be used to fund the design and construction of the West Street Sewer Line Replacement Project; the design, repairs, and upgrades to the Route 190 Pump Station; the Williamson Road Bridge, that's also being funded with a matching State grant; and, the repair of roads, and/or other critical infrastructure projects that are deemed necessary. Representatives from the Water Pollution Control Authority, Board of Finance, Board of Selectmen, along with the Director of Public Works, Town of Stafford CEO, Bond Counsel from Shipmen and Goodwin and representatives from Hilltop Securities will be present to answer all questions that may arise.

Upon presentation and discussion, there will be a vote to approve the funding and move forward with these projects.

We urge you to attend this meeting and support these projects that require urgent attention to move forward with positive growth of the community.

**The Town is Proposing to Bond \$6 Million for the following Projects:**

**Road Improvements**

The Town will follow the recommendations of the newly developed Engineered Road Management Plan to Repair, Repave and/or Chip Seal Roads (list of Roads to follow)

Replacement of Drainage Piping, Catch Basins and Pavement on West St. from Center St. to Rt 190      **\$ 530,914**      11%

Installation of New Sidewalks from Green St. to the New Cumberland Farms

**Williamson Road Bridge Replacement**

A Grant for 50% of the Bridge Replacement was received and the Town will pay this amount      **\$ 531,750**      9%

**Utility Improvements**

Complete Sewer Line replacement on West St. and Rt 190      **\$ 2,168,015**      36%

Due to the existing broken and undersized piping

Rebuilding of RT190 Pump Station (30 years old)

WPCA Payment is 18.07% of the project      **\$ 1,084,008**

Town's Payment is 81.93% of the project      **\$ 4,915,992**

Total      **\$ 6,000,000**      100%
