

**LEGAL NOTICE
TAXPAYERS, TOWN OF STAFFORD**

**PER EXECUTIVE ORDER 9R signed by Governor Ned Lamont December 16, 2020
The Town of Stafford has extended the grace period for January 2021 installments**

All persons liable to pay Property Taxes in the Town of STAFFORD are notified that the **SECOND INSTALLMENT** of taxes and motor vehicle taxes on the **SUPPLEMENT** list on the Grand List of October 1, 2019 are **due January 1, 2021** and payable without interest through **April 1, 2021**. Failure to pay the tax on or before **April 1, 2021** will render the tax delinquent and interest will be charged at the rate of 1+1/2% per month **from the due date** OR a MINIMUM INTEREST OF \$2.00. The higher amount prevails, **AND INTEREST APPLIES SEPARATELY TO THE TOWN AND DISTRICT**.

Taxes can be mailed to P.O. Box 111 Stafford Springs, CT 06076; online at staffordct.org; put in the black drop box located on the railroad track side of town hall.

Beginning December 14, 2020 Town Hall is closed to the public. Staff will still be working and are just a phone call/email away to ensure continued service to residents.
